







Revitalization Project: Visual PreferenceSurvey





### **SUMMARY: MOST PREFERRED CONCEPTS**










The top four preferred concepts included painted koi, suspended red lanterns, and suspended multicolored umbrellas. Not ony were these the most preferred concepts, they also received very little negative feedback, indicating a consensus of ideas.

### SUMMARY: LEAST PREFERRED CONCEPTS









The concepts with the most negative feedback featured graffiti, human statues, a noodle enclosure, and a giant red ball. These were among the most experimental ideas on the concept boards, with bold statements and colors.

- Describe (in open answer format) their vision for Maynard Alley
- Give any additional comments

Survey participants were most interested in storefronts activity, street performers, street vendors, art/sculpture, lighting, and landscape elements.

Some visions for Maynard Alley:

- + "A symbol for the CID"
- + "Make it inviting for the public and represent the diverse cultures of the ID"
- +"An alley without shady activities like drugs, prostitution, or public urination"
- + "A beautiful and safe street connector with retail activity"
- + "An activated space with natural foot traffic that is better connected between the two sections"
